Vessel Sinks

Vessel-style sinks sit on top of a vanity counter and make a design statement. MTI offers a wide selection of designs, sizes and shapes of vessel sinks that either mimic or complement the designs of MTI tubs.



Semi-Recessed Sinks

This style of sink has become increasingly popular because it allows the top portion of the sink to serve as a design element with the rest of the sink bowl being submerged below the surface. The result is that there is less mass sitting on the vanity counter, and semi-recessed sinks do not require a tall faucet. MTI has a nice assortment of semi-recessed sinks.



Undermount Sinks

This installation leaves none of the sink showing above the counter. Instead, a hole matching the shape of the sink is cut into the counter top, and the top of the sink lip is fastened to the underside of the counter top. A very popular installation, and MTI has many undermountable sinks from which to choose.



Counter-Sinks

These are right on-trend for a minimalist look with full functionality. MTI Counter-Sinks seamlessly integrate the sink bowl with the counter top and complement a variety of design aesthetics. And they are completely customizable in counter length, depth and height; bowl style and position(s); wall mount or vanity mount.
