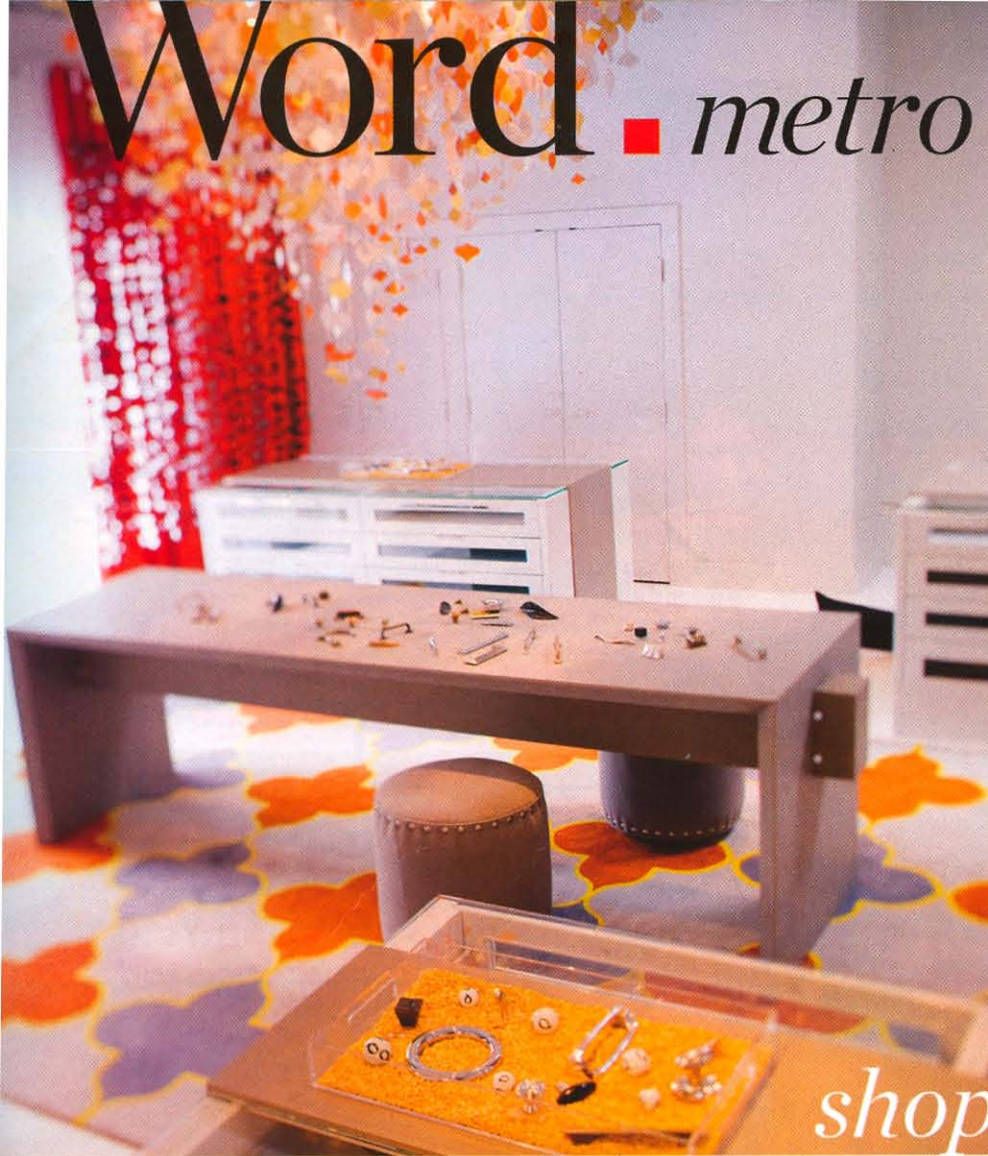

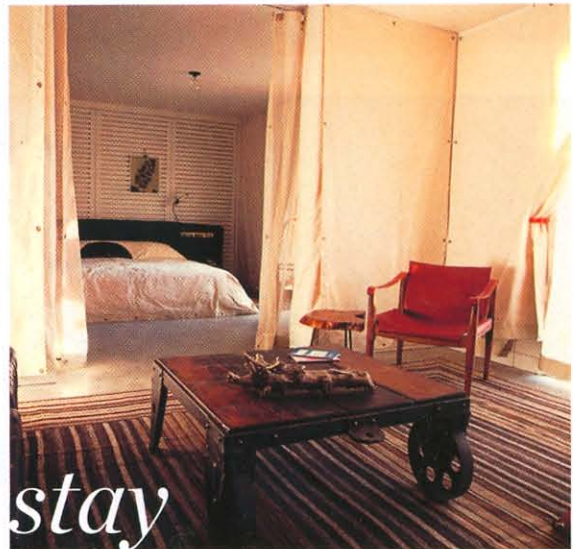

Peruvian celebrity chef Gastón Acurio serves up several kinds of cebiche (or seviche) in his new Pier 1½ hotspot. Designed by local architect Cass Calder Smith, the 11,000-square-foot space is spiced up with richly stained mahogany, Corian, stainless steel and vivid blue glass. Try the Clásico cebiche with habanero-spiked halibut, corn and yams (\$18) or the Nikei cebiche with ahi tuna, avocado and Japanese cucumber (\$17). (415/397-8880; LaMarCebicheria.com).—KL

ace hotel & swim club / palm springs

A decade ago, when the first Ace Hotel opened, in a rehabbed Seattle halfway house, its edgy style struck a chord with budget-conscious, creative travelers. The brand has since expanded and now includes a branch in Palm Springs, where the L.A. design firm Commune transformed a vintage Howard Johnson's motor lodge into an oasis of desert hip.
